

2012 Fairport Harbor VILLAGE VALUABLES MARKET—Information, Rules and Guidelines

Location: Fairport Harbor Veterans Memorial Park, Third and Eagle Street, Fairport Harbor, OH

Date and hours: The market will be held Saturday, June 09, 2012. 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Rain date will be Sunday, June 10, 2012. Regardless of the day the event is held (Sat. or Sun.), vendors who do not show up will not receive a refund.

Fees and Spaces: Spaces will be numbered and assigned to vendors on a “first come, first reserved” basis.

A single 12’X12’ space is \$20; a double space 24’X12 is \$30. (Food vendors selling food to be consumed at the event will receive a discount of \$5 for single, \$10 for double space. Food vendors must contact Lake Co. Health Department for a permit.

We accept checks or money orders payable to: FHTC, C/O 402 Eagle Street, Fairport Harbor, OH 44077. Deadline for registration is June 2, 2012. Fees from vendors are nonrefundable.

Set-up: Vendor set up will begin at 7 a.m. the morning of the market. Check in at the Park Gazebo upon arrival for space assignment. All vendors must be set up before 9 a.m. Tear down may not begin before 4 p.m. closing. Parking is available nearby. Please do not park around the park, leave that parking for attendees. Each vendor is responsible for tent/canopy, tables, chairs, umbrellas, etc. Neither water nor electricity will be available.

All sellers are required to pack out all their trash, garbage, boxes, unsold items, etc. Please do not use trash cans in the park; these are intended for customer food related disposal. Leave your space as you found it. **SO PLEASE PACK OUT ALL YOUR TRASH, GARBAGE, BOXES, AND UNSOLD ITEMS.** Thank you for your cooperation.

Wares: Antiques, collectibles, handcrafted items, and arts and crafts will be given priority. The Village of Fairport Harbor and the FH Tourism Council has the authority to decline any vendor whose merchandise it deems not appropriate. We appreciate each vendor’s efforts to make the Market attractive and an asset to Fairport Harbor, especially the residents nearby.

Liability: The Village of Fairport Harbor and the Fairport Harbor Tourism Council are not responsible for any illness or injury sustained as a result of any individual vendor or customer participating at the Market. All transactions shall be made between individuals and shall not involve the Village of Fairport Harbor and/or the Fairport Harbor Tourism Council.

Restricted items: No alcohol, medicine, drugs, drug paraphernalia, pets, pornography, poppers, fireworks, switchblades, fixed blades longer than 2 ½", firearms, or weapon sales or distribution. Only articles and merchandise in good taste and not offensive will be allowed to be sold or in the possession of sellers while on Village property.

Thank you for your patronage, and we hope you have a successful day! There should be additional traffic with in the village on June 11th because the residents participate in the annual Community Garage Sale which has been held the 2nd Saturday in June for the past 10+ years. Residents from Lake County and surrounding counties look forward to visiting the village annually on Garage Sale Day. **Village Valuables Market and the Fairport Harbor Public Library Side Yard Sale** will be a great addition to the day.
