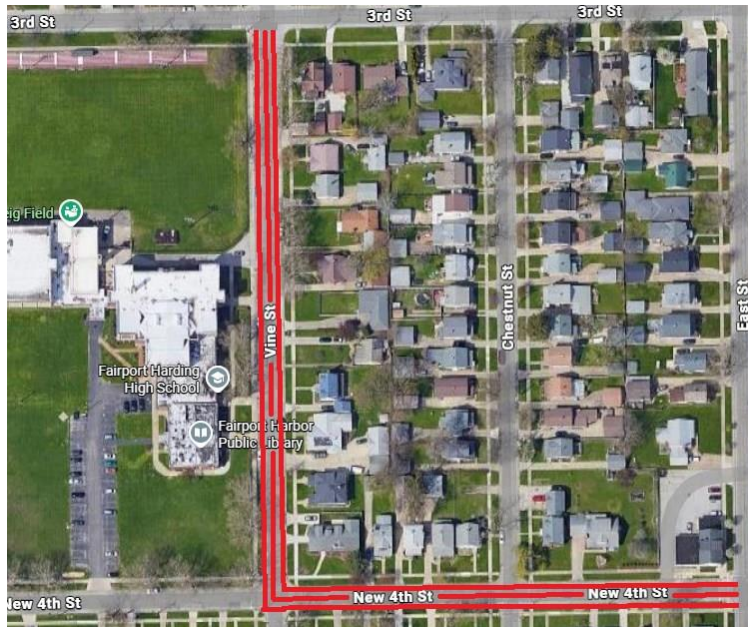

## COMMUNITY POLICING OTHER DEPT. ACTIONS

### PARKING RESTRICTION (School Demolition and Traffic Congestion)



Beginning Wednesday, January 14, 2026, at 6:00 AM, a temporary police order establishing a no-parking zone was implemented in the 300 block of Vine Street and the 500 block of New Fourth Street. The restriction will be enforced Monday through Friday from 6:00 AM to 5:00.

This measure is intended to ensure safe traffic flow during school pick-up and drop-off times and to support demolition activities at the former Fairport Harding High School and Library buildings by maintaining clear access for emergency vehicles and free-flowing traffic.

The Police Department respectfully requests the Village Council's approval of this temporary no-parking restriction for a period longer than 30 days. We estimate that at least six months will be required before we can reassess the situation. This will allow the Village to maintain a safe environment for students, residents, contractors, and emergency responders during this period.
