EQUIPMENT:

- We have just purchased two additional Patrol Eyes Body Cameras to accompany our fleet of Body Cams.
- We also purchased a dash camera for the new Unit 782.

EMPLOYEE ACTIONS / TRAINING

- Chief Koran attended the 2025 OCJS Summit in Columbus. Various topics were offered over the two days, including updated training on accreditation compliance.
- All Officers are starting the 2025 CPT training through OPOTC.

- Cadet Platia has completed the police academy and passed his exam. Ptl. Platia will be sworn in to fill the last full-time position we currently have open.
- Ptl. Drugovich has decided to step down from part-time status but will remain as a commissioned Auxiliary Officer with our department.
- We had range requalification this month, and all personnel passed for handgun, rifle, and shotgun.
- TASER recertifications will be on May 16th, and May 27th. Ptl. Sheba, a part-time officer with us, is now a certified TASER instructor and will conduct the recertifications.
- Departmental training will be on June 4th for various police topics and policy.

This vehicle was made possible through grant funding from the ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act of 2021). This new addition, part of our patrol vehicle replacement program, helps ensure our officers have the tools to respond quickly and safely. This patrol vehicle, a 2024 Ford Police Interceptor, will replace our previous Ford, which has been in front-line service since 2015. We will also retire our last remaining Dodge Charger patrol vehicle, which was purchased in 2011.
